- Willing to join GEF volunteer committees and actively support Board initiatives.
- Have strong communication and organization skills.
- Enjoy creative projects and collaborating with others.

- 2. Acquire a letter of recommendation from a Grafton School District teacher with whom you have had recent, direct contact.

- 4. Applications are due by June 5th for the following school year.
- Applications will be reviewed by the GEF Board of Directors in June and potential Ambassadors will be interviewed in July-August. New Student Ambassadors will be announced before the school year begins.
