8/18 Meeting A District Wide Initiative is being implemented

called PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention and Support). There has been 10 years of data collect on how this program can increase learning time and decrease office referrals. Goal of program is to develop consistency in behavior expectations and focus on proactive interventions. Middle School Principal met with Julia and has indicated that their needs to assist with this program include incentive donations (gift cards, spirit wear, sponsorship

of speakers, etc.)

Summer School Program went very well. Program attendance has continued to grow

since its inception in 2011.
